

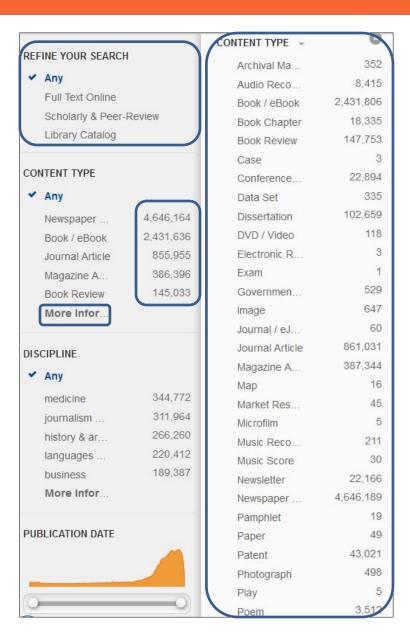

  - Some facets collapsed by default
  - Facet counts viewed with mouse-over
  - More link opens new pane
- Ability to select multiple facets at one time
- Added facet of Discipline

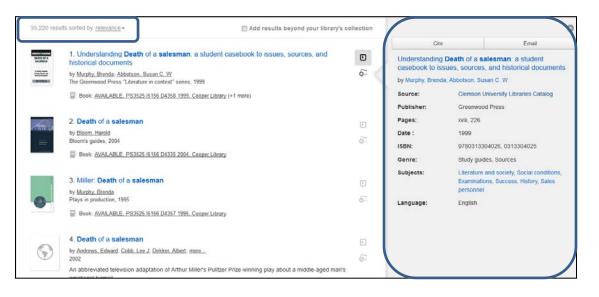

#### Contextual:

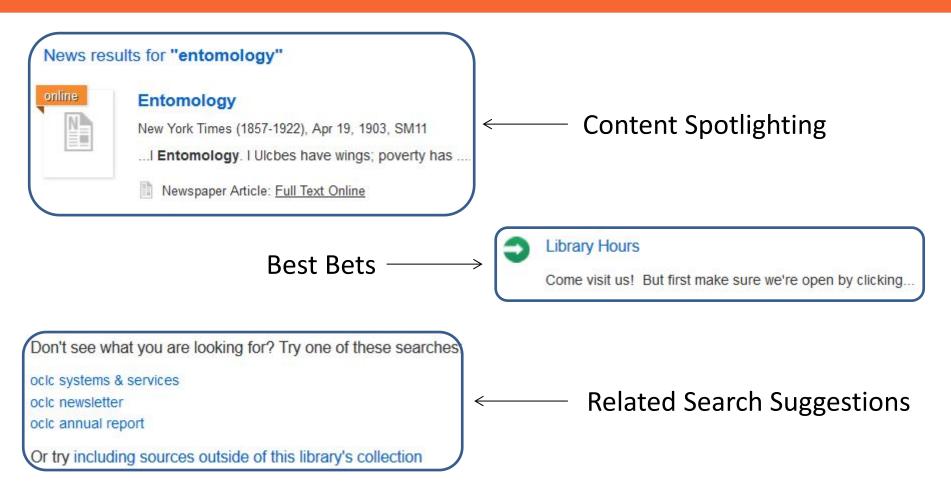

- Citations can be viewed, emailed, printed, and exported

- Persistent location for users to store their data without the need to export it
